COURSE PTA3400: MATERIAL HANDLING

Students develop knowledge, skills and attitudes in the areas of material handling, receiving, stocking and staging techniques.

Prerequisite: PTA3900: Apprenticeship Safety

COURSE PTA3405: STORAGE & PACKING

Students develop knowledge, skills and attitudes in the areas of material storage; picking and issuing freight; and the proper process for packing goods.

Prerequisites: PTA3900: Apprenticeship Safety, PTA3400: Material Handling

COURSE PTA3410: SHIPPING & RETURNS

Students develop knowledge, skills and attitudes in the areas of shipping products, dealing with product returns and ensuring adequate stock maintenance.

Prerequisites: PTA3900: Apprenticeship Safety, PTA3400: Material Handling

COURSE PTA3415: MERCHANDISING

Students develop knowledge, skills and attitudes in the areas of merchandising, material handling equipment and the use of catalogues.

Prerequisites: PTA3900: Apprenticeship Safety, PTA3400: Material Handling, PTA3405: Storage & Packing, PTA3410: Shipping & Returns

COURSE PTA3420: MEASUREMENT & STOCK

Students develop knowledge, skills and attitudes in doing measurement calculations and using measurement tools; identifying standard stock items; and identifying consumables.

Prerequisite: PTA3900: Apprenticeship Safety

COURSE PTA3425: ELECTRICAL BASICS

Students develop knowledge, skills and attitudes around electrical fundamentals, electrical circuits and battery fundamentals.

COURSE PTA3430: SUSPENSION & WHEELS

Students learn about the operation and components of bearings, seals and suspension systems and about wheels, tires and hubs.
