

# Alberta Official Statistics

## Knowledge of Official Languages, Alberta, Calgary and Edmonton CMAs

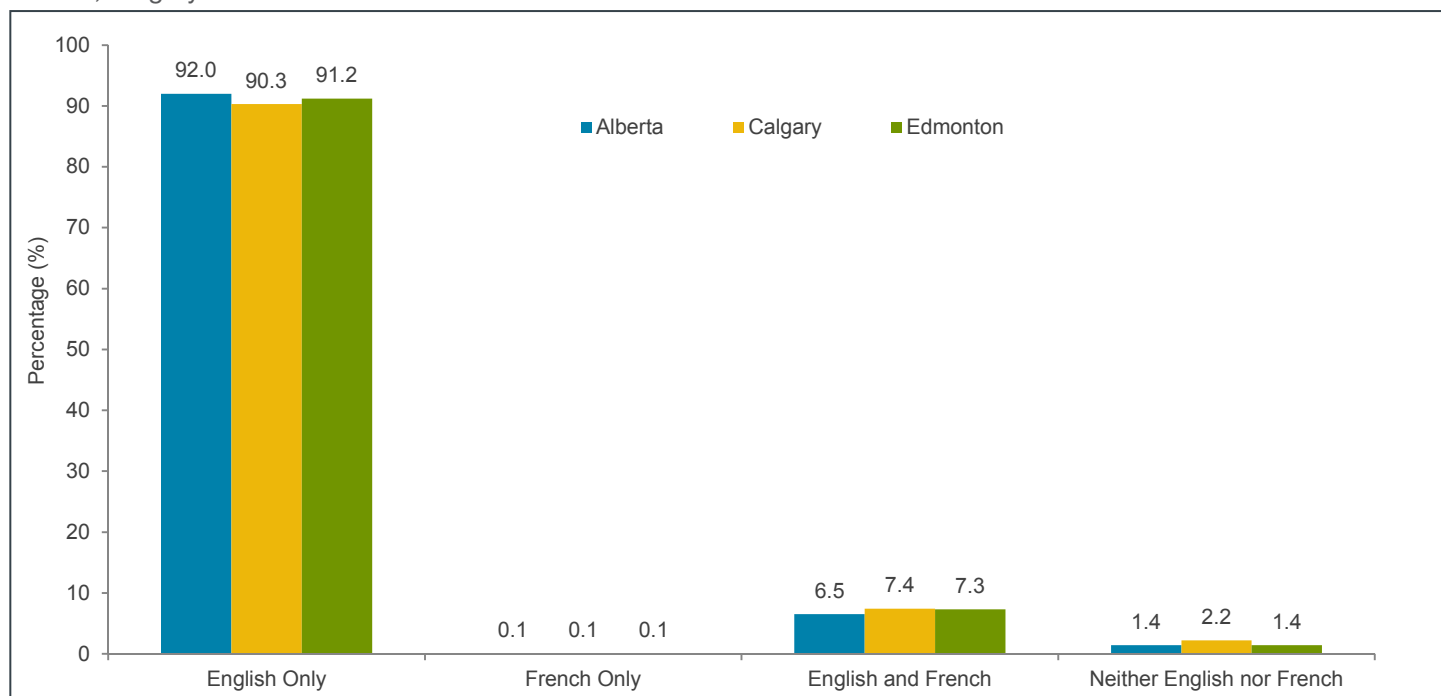
- According to the 2011 Census, 92.0% of Albertans spoke English<sup>1</sup> but not French, while 0.1% spoke French but not English. Six-and-a-half percent (6.5%) of Albertans spoke both English and French, while 1.4% spoke neither English nor French.
- In the Calgary CMA<sup>2</sup>, 90.3% of the population spoke English but not French, 0.1% spoke French but not English, 7.4% spoke both English and French and 2.2% spoke neither English nor French.
- In the Edmonton CMA, 91.2% of the population spoke English but not French, 0.1% spoke French but not English, 7.3% spoke both English and French and 1.4% spoke neither English nor French.

<sup>1</sup> Knowledge of Official Languages refers to the ability to conduct a conversation in English only, in French only, in both English and French, or in neither English nor French.

<sup>2</sup> A CMA is a "Census Metropolitan Area" as defined by Statistics Canada.
