(The above are collectively referred to as the "Parties")

WHEREAS the Company and Greenways were issued Enforcement Order No. EO-2012/01-NR (the "EO") on May 23, 2012;

WHEREAS the EO was amended by the issuance of Amendment No.1 on June 21, 2012 ("Amendment No.1");

WHEREAS since Amendment No.1 to the EO was issued the Parties have submitted information to the Director regarding the plans to be prepared and the timeframes for providing the information and carrying out the required tasks set out in the EO as amended;

WHEREAS Jeff Toering, District Compliance Manager, Northern Region, (the "Manager") has been appointed a Director under the Act for the purposes of issuing and amending enforcement orders and environmental protection orders;

THEREFORE, I, Jeff Toering, District Compliance Manager, Northern Region, pursuant to section 212 of the Act, DO HEREBY AMEND the EO as follows:

## ORDER THAT:

1. Paragraph 4 of the EO which reads as follows:

"WHEREAS on October 5, 2011, the city of Edmonton Drainage Department and the City of Edmonton Fire Department Hazmat Team responded to a call that nickel solution from a tank that had been overturned on the Lands had entered into the storm drain system;"

Be deleted and replaced with the following:

"WHEREAS on October 5, 2011, the City of Edmonton Drainage Department and the City of Edmonton Fire Department Hazmat Team responded to a call that diluted nickel solution had been released onto a paved parking lot and may have entered into the storm drainage system;"

2. Clause 10 of the EO is amended by replacing the phrase "August 20, 2012" with the phrase "September 30, 2012".
