

DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND ECONOMIC CORRIDORS REGISTRAR'S EXEMPTION

The Director, Permitting & Approvals, of Alberta Transportation and Economic Corridors, pursuant to section 114 of Alberta's Vehicle Equipment Regulation, (VER) subject to the conditions and restrictions noted below, hereby exempts motor vehicles operated by a transportation network driver, or a taxi driver, from the requirements of sections 4(2) and (4) of the VER, to allow the installation and use of a transportation network company ("TNC") lamp, or a taxi "for hire" lamp.

Conditions:

- 1) The taxi service or TNC must be authorized or licensed by the Registrar or the municipality it is operating in, as applicable.
- 2) A motor vehicle operated as a taxi may have a roof top "for hire" lamp.
- 3) A motor vehicle operated by a transportation network driver may have a "TNC" lamp which identifies the transportation network driver as online the network.
- 4) The taxi "for hire" lamp may only be activated when a taxi is available for hire.
- 5) The "TNC" lamp may only be activated in connection with picking up or dropping off a rider
- 6) Lamps allowed by this exemption may vary their brightness while the vehicle is available for service, or when picking up or dropping off a rider.
- 7) Lamps allowed by this exemption may change colour.
- 8) The taxi "for hire" or "TNC" lamps may not emit red or blue light.
- 9) This exemption may be amended, suspended, or cancelled at any time.

This exemption expires on December 1, 2028.
