COMMUNITY EDUCATIONAL INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT

CONSTRUCTION OF PRE-SCHOOL AND DAYCARE SPACES AT ÉCOLE SILVERADO

ALBERTA

Target years: 2022-23 to 2025-26¹

This project is funded under the Canada–Alberta Agreement on Minority-Language Education and Second-Language Instruction 2020-21 to 2022-23

Project Description

The Government of Alberta, in collaboration with the FrancoSud school board, is requesting funding to expand the footprint of the New South Calgary School Complex for the Southern Francophone communities of the Silverado neighborhood. The proposed project will provide adequate space needed to host the daycare and pre-school programs at École Silverado school complex.

FrancoSud has two other schools located in the South-East area of Calgary and their early childhood programs are at capacity. The students and families at FrancoSud South Calgary School Complex K-6 and 7-12 need dedicated spaces to gather and expand the possibilities of additional supports and services to ensure the transmission and vitality of the French language and culture.

The province of Alberta approved the construction of the new school that will have the capacity to accommodate 350 students from Kindergarten to Grade 12 and will allow students to complete their primary and secondary education at the same Francophone school. The school will feature amenities such as a Gymnasium Complex, a Library, a Gathering/Flex Space and a Theatre that will be available to the Francophone community for activities and events during and after school hours. In addition, this project will expand the school footprint by providing 260 square meters to dedicated community spaces. The community spaces include 200 square meters to accommodate 40 children in the pre-school and daycare programs for the local Francophone community, 50 square meters of additional administration space and 10 square meters of additional gender-neutral bathroom space.

École Silverado is located in the Silverado neighbourhood (100 Silverado Dr. SW) in SW Calgary. The school is located in an area undergoing significant population growth and housing development. The nearest francophone school is École de la Source (K-12, 449 capacity, 448 enrolment & 100% utilization). The new École Silverado will alleviate enrolment pressures at École de la Source, accommodate the population growth in SW Calgary and reduce the busing of francophone students to École de la Source.
