Report Workplace Health and Safety Incidents

It's the law to report certain types of health and safety incidents to Alberta Occupational Health and Safety. Here's how.

What happened

Notify OHS

- A worker fatality at the work site
- A workplace injury, illness or incident that resulted in:
 - a worker fatality
 - a worker being admitted to hospital
 - a worker injury or illness that the employer believes may lead to hospital admission
- An unplanned or uncontrolled explosion, fire or flood
- A crane, derrick or hoist collapse or upset
- A (full or partial) building or structural collapse or failure
- A worker is overexposed to radiation
- A mine or mine site incident
- A potentially serious incident
