ASIRT investigations concluded on two files

The Alberta Serious Incident Response Team (ASIRT) has completed its investigations into two separate incidents and released the assistant executive director's full reports on them.

On June 15, 2020, pursuant to Sec. 46.1 of the *Police Act*, ASIRT was directed to investigate allegations of assault against two Leduc RCMP officers. ASIRT's investigation is now complete.

On July 14, 2020, pursuant to Sec. 46.1 of the *Police Act*, ASIRT was directed to investigate a fatal motor vehicle collision following a pursuit by Edmonton Police Service officers. ASIRT's investigation is now complete.
