**Amusement Ride Standards Regulation AR 214/97;
Amusement Rides Regulation AR 270/89 and amendments AR 203/92**

**SUBJECT: Quality Assurance Plan Guidelines for Amusement Rides Operating
in Alberta**

Background

The Amusement Ride Technical Council and Alberta Municipal Affairs have developed this Information Bulletin to assist owners in developing a "*Quality Assurance Plan*" for amusement rides under their control, to more easily meet the requirements of the regulation under the Safety Codes Act.

Legislation

In accordance with Section (5) of the Safety Codes Act, an owner is to ensure that any thing, process or activity to which this Act applies is done in a safe manner.

It is recommended that the attached "*Quality Assurance Plan*" guidelines be used to assist the owner meet the requirements of the "*Amusement Regulations*" under the "*Safety Codes Act*".

General Information

The owner/operator can assemble the information required by the Regulations and Standards in any manner they choose. However, the use of the "*Quality Assurance Plan Guidelines*" should make the task of meeting the requirements cost effective and less complicated.
