TITLE: SUPERVISION OF PROVINCIALLY REGULATED RECIPROCAL

INSURANCE EXCHANGES

DATE: March 2013

PURPOSE

The purpose of this interpretation bulletin is to notify all Reciprocal Insurance Exchanges either formed under the Alberta *Insurance Act*, or who have transferred to Alberta such that Alberta is their primary regulator (provincially regulated reciprocal insurance exchanges) of the Alberta Superintendent of Insurance's (Superintendent) supervisory standard.

The supervision of provincially regulated reciprocal insurance exchanges will be generally consistent with the supervision of provincially incorporated property and casualty insurers with respect to governance, risk management and solvency. The Superintendent will consider the size, risk, complexity and structure of each provincially regulated reciprocal insurance exchange when determining the applicability of relevant legislation, regulations and guidelines.
