DIRECTOR'S ORDER

March 31, 2020

Public Land Use Zone Restriction Order

I, Lisa Sadownik, Assistant Deputy Minister, Lands Division, being a designated director under the *Public Lands Act* hereby make the following order pursuant to Section 184 of the Public Lands Administration Regulation:

- 1. The parking of a motor vehicle within:
 - a. any designated parking lot or staging area in any of the public land use zones listed in the attached Schedule; or
 - b. any location in a public land use zone listed in the attached Schedule if that location is within one kilometer of a:
 - i. public land recreation area;
 - ii. public land recreation trail;
 - iii. Provincial Park established under the *Provincial Parks Act*, RSA 2000, c. P-40; or
 - iv. Provincial Recreation Area established under the *Provincial Parks Act*, RSA 2000, c. P-40;

is restricted to those exceptions set out in section 2.

- 2. The parking of a motor vehicle is permitted with respect to any of the following:
 - a. any individual when exercising a right recognized and affirmed under Part II of the *Constitution Act, 1982* or a right under section 12 of the Natural



Resources Transfer Agreement or when travelling to a location to exercise such a right;

- b. any individual who is carrying out duties as an employee, agent or contractor of the Government of Alberta;
- c. any person (including any employee, agent or contractor of that person) who is accessing the Lands for the purpose of exercising any right pursuant to a disposition issued under the *Public Lands Act*, a registered fur management agreement under the *Wildlife Act*, or a timber disposition under the *Forests Act*; and
- d. any person providing emergency services or carrying out law enforcement functions.
- 3. Public access to any building or facility in a public land use zone listed in the attached Schedule is prohibited. This prohibition does not apply to any building or facility operated by a disposition holder under the *Public Lands Act*.
- 4. This Order does not apply to the operation of an off-highway vehicle or a snow vehicle, as those terms are defined in section 177(1) of the Public Lands Administration Regulation.
- 5. This Order repeals and replaces Public Land Use Zone Restriction Order (Director's Order) made on March 27, 2020.

This Order comes into effect at	12 pm	on March _	31	, 2020
and remains in effect until further r	notice.
