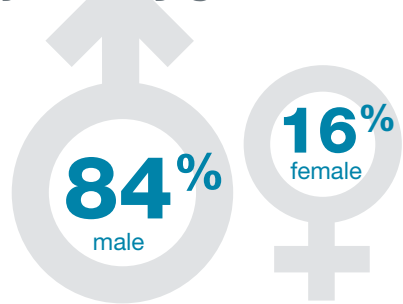

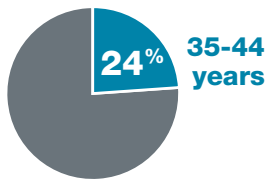
Injury claims by workers in 2017

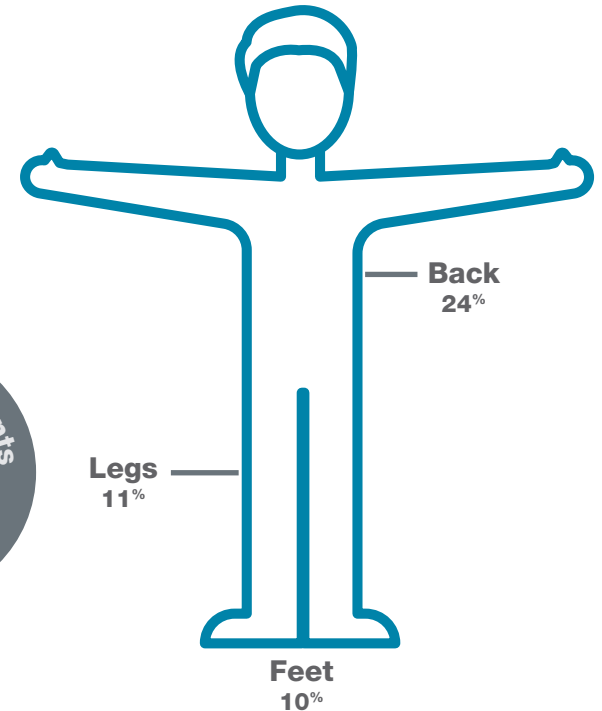
