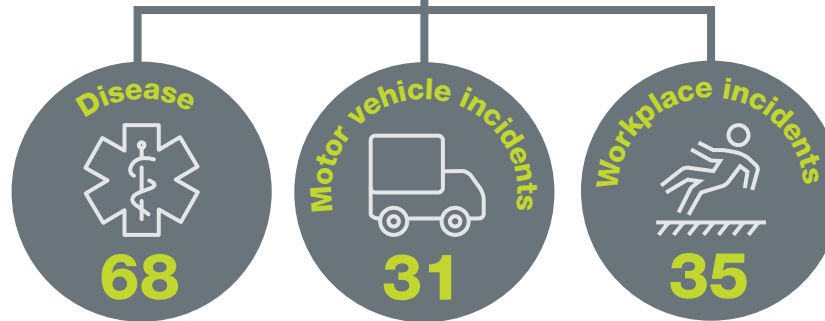


Sectors with the highest injury claim rates in 2017:

- Provincial & municipal government, education & health services

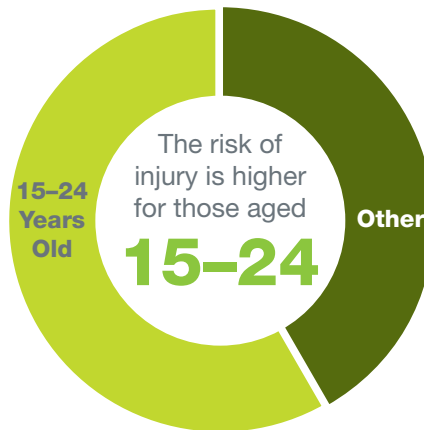
Occupations with the highest injury claims in 2017:

Top three causes of injuries among workers:

Overexertion	22%
Falls	18%
Bodily reaction	13%
