Sinopharm, Sinovac, and Covaxin:

- For those who have received one dose of Sinopharm, Sinovac, and Covaxin see Management of COVID-19 Vaccine Administration Errors and Deviations for series completion.
- See biological pages for recommendations for additional/third/booster doses. A dose of mRNA vaccine is recommended for all those that have not received any doses of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine. However, this is not required to be considered "fully immunized"

Booster/additional/third doses are not part of the proof of immunization under the Restrictions Exemption Program.

History of COVID-19 infection and/or positive serology does not constitute proof of immunity.
