

# Defining Fully Immunized – COVID-19

AstraZeneca/COVISHIELD	Pfizer, Moderna or AstraZeneca/COVIDSHIELD	2 doses with at least 28 days between doses	At least 14 days following second dose
Janssen	N/A	1 dose	At least 14 days following dose
WHO Approved (Non- Health Canada approved and not available in Canada)			
Sinovac (Sinovac Life Science Co., Ltd.)	Sinovac	2 doses with at least 14 days between doses	At least 14 days following second dose
Sinopharm (SinoPharm Beijing Institute of Biological Products)	Sinopharm	2 doses with at least 21 days between doses	At least 14 days following second dose

## NOTES:

*Sinopharm and Sinovac are **NOT** interchangeable with Pfizer, Moderna or AstraZeneca/COVISHIELD.*

*For those who have received two doses of Sinopharm and Sinovac (Non Health Canada approved) – an additional dose of Pfizer and/or Moderna is **recommended** however, not required.*

*Booster/additional/third doses are not part of the proof of immunization under the Restrictions Exemption Program.*

*History of COVID-19 infection and/or serology does not constitute proof of immunity.*
