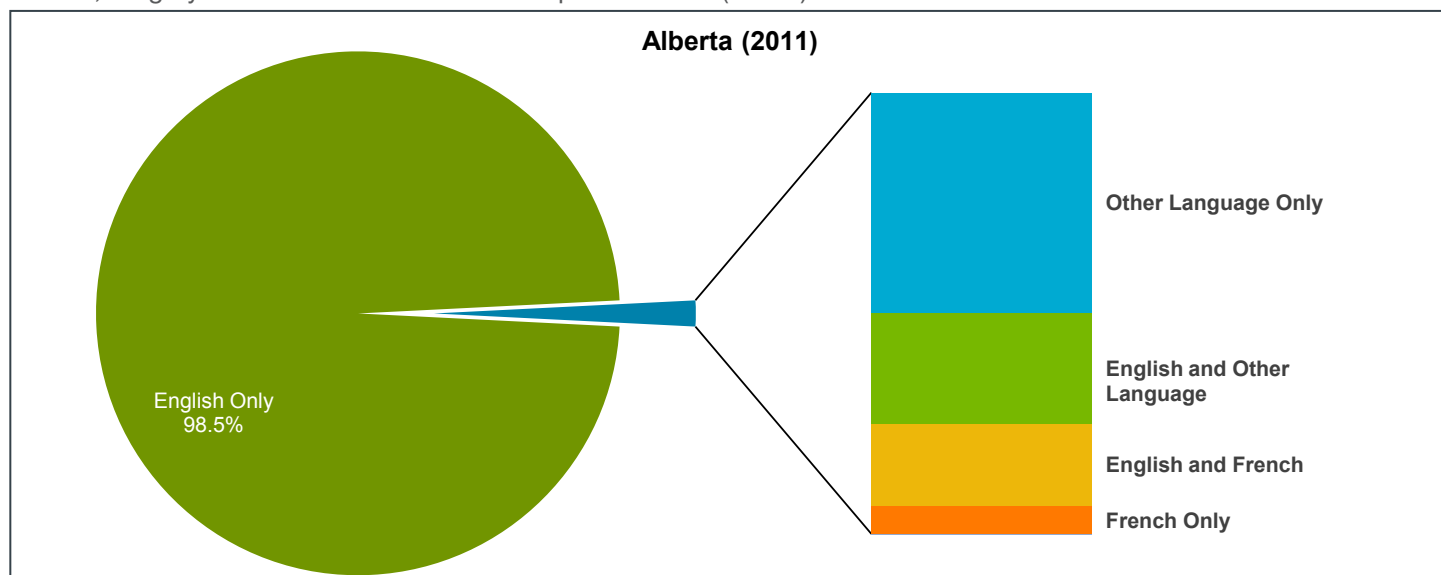
Language Used Most Often at Work, Alberta, Calgary and Edmonton Census Metropolitan Areas (CMAs)

- English is the language most often used at work in Alberta: 98.5% of the population used only English according to the 2011 National Household Survey (NHS).
- Small proportions of the population used only French at work (0.3%) or only used a language other than English or French (0.8%). There were also small proportions of the population who used English and French at work (0.1%), or who used English and an 'Other' language (0.4%).
- Comparing the two CMA's¹ of Alberta, Edmonton reported a slightly higher proportion of people who used only English at work (98.4%) compared to Calgary (98.0%). Both CMA's reported that 0.3% of the population used French only and 0.1% used English and French at work. A slightly higher proportion of Calgarians than Edmontonians reported using a language other than English or French.
