ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ORDER NO. EPO-2020/01-SR

AMENDMENT NO. 1

WHEREAS Enforcement Order No. EPO-2020/01-SR (the "Order") was issued to JBS on August 10, 2020;

WHEREAS on December 4, 2020, a clerical error was identified in Clauses 9 and 10 of the Order;

WHEREAS section 212(1) of the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act* provides authority for the Director to amend an enforcement order;

WHEREAS Coreen Bates, Acting Compliance Manager, is designated as a Director under the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act* for the purposes of issuing and amending Orders (the "Director");

THEREFORE, I Coreen Bates, pursuant to section 212(1) of the EPEA DO HEREBY AMEND the Order as follows:

1. Deleting Clauses 10(a) and 10(d)(ii) of the Order.
2. In Clause 10(e) of the Order, deleting the words "**February 1, 2021**", and replacing them with "**February 1, 2022**".
3. Adding Clauses 11 and 12 as follows:
 11. JBS shall by **March 5, 2021**, submit to the Director, for the Director's approval, a written Short-Term Industrial Wastewater Plan that has been prepared and signed by a qualified environmental professional who is currently registered in good standing with the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Alberta, or the Alberta Institute of Agrology;
 12. In the Short-Term Industrial Wastewater Plan, JBS must include at least each of the following:

- a. A root cause analysis for the circumstances that led to the need for an emergency release of industrial wastewater;
- b. Short-term measures which JBS can immediately implement to prevent the circumstances that led to the need for an emergency release of industrial wastewater.
