Wheelchair Approved Product List

There have been a number of updates to the AADL Wheelchair APL.

- Quickie QX has replaced the Breezy 600
- Compostie Move has been added to Category A Manual Wheelchairs
- Dynamic Supertilt is now called Maple Leaf
 Lowrider
- Orion II is back on the APL
- Physipro Neox has been added to the Adult Tilt-in-Space category
- Myon Junior has been added to the Pediatric Category A wheelchair
- Permobile FX and Pride 4 Front which have front wheel drive has been added to the Adult Power Wheelchairs.

All lifters funded by AADL can use slings from any manufacturer (compatable slings).

The Invacare Reliant 450 lifter has been removed from the APL but AADL will continue to fund the Invacare slings for clients that currently have this model of lifter.

AADL will no longer be posting manufacturer specification sheets on the AADL website. All manufacturers will be expected to have the AADL approved order forms/specification sheets on the manufacturer websites.

Authorizers should work with the vendors and the manufacturers to access order forms.

AADL has posted an exclusion list for manual and power wheelchairs. This list is not exhaustive but is intended to assist authorizers and vendors in clarifying what options and products are not funded by AADL to avoid confusion when ordering.
